## **30-Hour Construction Industry Required Course Topics** Mandatory (15 hours) Electives (12 hours) Choose at least 6 of the following topics. Introduction to OSHA (2 hours) Minimum length of any topic is 30 minutes. Managing Safety and Health (2 Hours) **Concrete and Masonry Construction Confined Space Entry** OSHA Focus Four Hazards (6 Hours) (1) Falls (minimum one hour and 15 minutes) Cranes, Derricks, Hoists, Elevators, & (2) Electrocution Conveyors (3) Struck-By (e.g., falling objects, trucks, **Ergonomics** cranes) Excavations (4) Caught-In or Between (e.g., trench hazards, Fire Protection and Prevention equipment) Materials Handling, Storage, Use and Disposal Personal Protective Equipment and Lifesaving Motor Vehicles, Mechanized Equipment and Equipment (2 hours) Marine Operations; Rollover Protective Structures and Overhead Health Hazards in Construction (2 hours) Protection; and Signs, Signals and Barricades **Powered Industrial Vehicles** Stairways and Ladders (1 hour) Safety and Health Programs Scaffolds Steel Erection Tools - Hand and Power Welding and Cutting Foundations for Safety Leadership (minimum 2.5 hours) **OPTIONAL THREE HOURS** Teach any other construction industry hazards or policies and/or expand on the mandatory and/or elective topics. Minimum length of any topic is 30 minutes.
